University Church of Christ Benevolence Focus: Union Rescue Mission

One of the many causes supported by the University Church of Christ's benevolence funds is the Union Rescue Mission, one of the oldest and largest faith-based homeless shelters in the United States. Los Angeles' "skid row" has a long and sad history; it came into existence in the late 1800s as a gathering place for uprooted people because it was the last stop on the trains heading West. In 1891 the Union Rescue Mission opened its doors on skid row, and it has been serving homeless people there ever since.

Los Angeles County estimates that on any given night up to 74,000 people are homeless in the County. In the past year alone the Union Rescue Mission served homeless people 735,909 meals, and it also provided many of them shelter and other important services. The Union Rescue Mission is a Christian organization, and its faith commitment is reflected in all of its services. In this year's benevolence budget the University Church of Christ provided \$3,400 to support the Union Rescue Mission.
